AMAZING HUMAN BODY

- In one square inch of skin there are four yards of nerve fibres, 1300 nerve cells, 100 sweat glands, 3 million cells, and 3 yards of blood vessels.
- Except for our brain cells, 50,000,000 of the cells in our body will have died and been replaced with others, all while reading this sentence.
- The adult heart beats about 40,000,000 times a year. In one hour the heart works hard enough to produce enough energy to raise almost one ton of weight one yard from the ground.
- Red blood cells make approximately 250,000 round trips of the body before returning to the bone marrow, where they were born, to die.


